

To contain the coronavirus, the following restrictions apply.

## **An overview**

### **Retail, stores and gastronomy**

Gastronomic establishments, in particular restaurants, pubs, taverns and catering establishments, *Straußwirtschaften*, bars, cafeterias, canteens, hotel restaurants and hotel bars, ice cream parlors and ice cream cafes may not sell alcoholic beverages every day between 11pm and 6am. This also applies to sales outlets and similar establishments, in particular petrol stations, kiosks, retail stores, and supermarkets. The opening hours of gastronomic establishments for pick-up and delivery services and takeaways and yard sales are limited to the time between 6am and 11pm every day.

### **Obligation to wear masks**

- Masks are compulsory on Prinzregentenstrasse, Bismarckstrasse, Ludwigstrasse, Rathausplatz, Ludwigsplatz, Schulstrasse (between Bismarckstrasse and Ludwigsplatz), Bahnhofstrasse (between Berliner Strasse and Rheingalerie), Kaiser-Wilhelm-Strasse (between Bismarckstrasse and Zollhofstrasse), Wredestrasse (between Bismarckstrasse and Lichtenbergerstrasse), Carl-Wurster-Platz, Berliner Platz and Mundenheimer Strasse (between Yorckstrasse and Pfalzgrafenstrasse).
- In secondary schools, the obligation to wear masks in class will apply
- In institutions for adult education, vocational training or further education, and in private educational institutions, a mouth-nose cover must also be worn in class.
- Adults present on playgrounds must wear a mask

### **Trade fairs and markets**

Trade fairs, exhibitions, flea markets, special markets and similar markets are prohibited in line with the State Law on Trade Fairs, Exhibitions and Markets where different goods are offered. Excluded from this are the weekly farmer's markets.
